### IMPORTANT NOTES

Placement exams in English and Math are required prior to registration.

Students must take **two** courses in each of the four knowledge domains and **one** general education elective from any of the four knowledge domains. Domains may be taken in any order.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all major and minor courses. You cannot take a course in your major or minor on a CR/NC basis.

Upper division courses have a catalog number of 3700 and higher.

The following courses DO NOT COUNT as hours toward graduation: ENGL 1509, 1512, 1539, 1540; MATH 1500, 1501, 1502, 1503, 1504, 1507; RSS 1510A and 1510B.

Classes taken and/or repeated out of sequence will NOT count toward graduation.

#### **Check prerequisites.**

It is recommended that all students meet with their advisor at least one time in an academic year. The following current students are REQUIRED to meet with an advisor before registration: freshmen, athletes, and students on warning or probation.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION

- GER model complete
- Minimum 30 s.h. in major
- Minimum 18 s.h. in minor
- 48 s.h. of upper division (3700+)
- Minimum of 124 total s.h.
- Residency requirement (transfer students only)
- Minimum of a 2.00 overall GPA
- One year prior to graduation, or at 80-85 s.h. (whichever comes first), request a "graduation evaluation" from the Division of Academic Advising in DeBartolo Hall, B15
- When your graduation evaluation is complete, make an appointment with your department chairperson to review it.
