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IMPORTANT NOTES

Placement exams in English and Math are required prior to registration.

Students must take **two** courses in each of the four knowledge domains and **one** general education elective from any of the four knowledge domains. Domains may be taken in any order.

A grade of "C" or better is required in all major and minor courses. You cannot take a course in your major or minor on a CR/NC basis.

Upper division courses have a catalog number of 3700 and higher.

The following courses DO NOT COUNT as hours toward graduation: ENGL 1509, 1512, 1539, 1540; MATH 1500, 1501, 1502, 1503, 1504, 1507; RSS 1510A and 1510B. Classes taken and/or repeated out of sequence will NOT count toward graduation.

Check prerequisites.

It is recommended that all students meet with their advisor at least one time in an academic year. The following current students are REQUIRED to meet with an advisor before registration: freshmen, athletes, and students on warning or probation.
